Meet Information and Competition Rules

1. The competition will be conducted under technical rules and anti-doping terms of the "DSV" (German Swim Organisation). With registration, teams have to declare that participation of their athletes is without any risks to health.
2. One-Start-Rule will be used in all events.
3. Age Groups:
female: '03 and older + '04/'05 + '06/'07 + '08/'09
male: '01 and older + '02/'03 + '04/'05 + '06-'09
4. Heats are set by reporting times and limited as follow:
all 25 m- / 50 m-events 20 heats
all 100 m-events 15 heats
all 200 m-events 8 heats
all 400 m-events 5 heats
all 800 m-/1500 m-events 4 heats
(3 heats with double assignments of lanes)
The race limit does not apply to foreign teams.
With dual lane assignment, the start takes place with a time delay (approx. 15 sec.) and with manual timekeeping. Every athlete starting here has to bring a lap counter for the turning bridge.
In the finals of the 25 and 50 m-events the 6 fastest swimmers each age group start. In the finals of the 100 m-events the youngest age group will be left out.




5. Places 1-3 of each age group will get a certificate.
Places 1-3 of each final (25, 50, 100 m and relay) will be honoured with Medals after the final. Best individual performance of men and women in each Age group will be honoured with non-cash prizes (according to the 1000-point Table from DSV).
6. For a new competition record, there is a bonus of 25,00 €.
The basis for this is the pre-published CR-list ("Veranstaltungsrekord") from the previous year (2018).
Event records from a first round will only be awarded if they are not improved in the later final. Only one new competition record per event is recognized.
For similar times (Heats/Finals) the first new record time counts. The record is announced in a timely manner. The bonus must be received in person at the Organisation-Office and will not be subsequently paid, shipped or transferred.

9. Registration has to be sent in dsv 6-format according to the linked document (DSV – Form 101) or in a open format (Name and surname of the swimmer, ID-number, gender, year, WK-number, track, style and time of registration).
10. The registration should include a check for the entry fee. In case of Email – registration please transfer the entry fee to our bank account or in exceptional cases pay it in cash at your arrival.

11. The organizer accepts no liability for accidents, theft or damages of any kind, as well as for termination of the event or of parts of the event in cases where the organizer is not responsible for the termination.



12. We will not send any starting list – the official list will be released on our website in a timely manner. There will be a version for corrections sent to you before – please give us a quick response at that time, so we can correct possible mistakes. **Paid entry fee for non-starting athletes will not be refunded. Late registration after the deadline (also substitutes) are not possible.**
13. Result lists will only be printed, when you explicitly ask for it. Electronic result data and lists will be sent via Email after the competition.
14. You can pick up your certificates after the sessions – we will only send it to you with a suitable prepaid envelope. We will not send trophies or awards, in cases where you missed to pick them up.
15. During the event photo and video recordings will be taken. By registering and participating in the International Neptune Contest athletes, coaches, carers and judges declare their consent.
16. The approval of the event was requested to the State Swimming Federation (SVMV, DSV).
17. Handicapped athletes with specific classification need to apply to the terms and conditions of the DBS (“Deutscher Behindertensportverband e.V.”) and the IPC (International Paralympic Committee).
18. On Saturday and Sunday appropriate lunch will be available. The menu order form will be published on our website soon. The order has to be made about 1 week before the start of the competition.
19. Every team is responsible for travel, accommodation and meals.
